Véronique de Goumoëns, RN, CNS, PhD, is an Associate Professor HES at the Institute and School of Nursing La Source in Lausanne, member of the network of the University of Applied Sciences of Western Switzerland (HES-SO). She is leading the Teaching and Research Laboratory "Child and Family Health".

She obtained her BScN in 2008 and her MScN in 2014. She is specialized in clinical neurosciences. She has been a Clinical Nurse Specialist (CNS) at the University Hospital of Lausanne (CHUV), a senior lecturer at HESAV School of Health Sciences, and a scientific collaborator at the University Institute of Higher Education and Research in Healthcare (IUFRS).

Her research focus on family nursing for patients with acquired brain injuries, from the early phase of hospitalization. In partnership with families and healthcare professionals, she developed a new intervention based on Family Nursing Systems Theory. Her intervention is currently testing in clinical neurosciences department of the Lausanne University Hospital. She is contributing to the development of the curriculum in family nursing for pre-graduate and graduate nursing students. Integrating the "family nursing" and "patient- and family-centered care" approaches, her teaching focuses on the development of students' skills by aiming for excellence in Family Nursing in the context of French-speaking Switzerland.

She is deputy director of the BEST (Bureau d'Echange des Savoirs pour des praTiques exemplaires de soins) JBI Center of Excellence, member of the Board of Directors of the National Association for Nursing Sciences (VFP-APSI), and co-chair of the Student Engagement Group within the International Family Nursing Association.
